## GENERAL WIRING DIAGRAM

- 1. Make sure the power is turned off before installing.
- 2. If a new hole is needed, cut opening in the ceiling (Fig. 1), refer to table above for opening diameter.
- 3. Connect remote driver to the power source, see General Wiring Diagram. Close the cover of the junction box.
- 4. Select color temperature using slider on the side of the remote driver. Make sure the switch is not in between selections. (Fig. 2)
- 5. Squeeze the spring clips so they are in an upright position and insert downlight into opening. (Fig. 3)
- 6. Once the downlight is inside the housing, release the spring clips and continue to pushing the downlight up until it is secure and flush with ceiling. (Fig. 4)
- 7. Restore power, installation is complete.
- 8. Once the fixture is mounted in the ceiling, caulk the space between the ceiling and the shell, if necessary.
