
- · Turn off electrical power at fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring fixture to the power supply.
- Turn off the power when you perform any maintenance.
- · Verify that supply voltage is correct by comparing it with the luminaire label information.
- Make all electrical and grounded connections in accordance with the National Electrical Code and any applicable local code requirements.
- All wiring connections should be capped with UL approved wire connectors.


CAUTION: RISK OF INJURY

- Risk of burn. Disconnect power and allow fixture to cool before handling fixture.
- Avoid direct eye exposure to the light source while it is on.
- Account for small parts and destroy packing material, as these may be hazardous to children.
- Green ground screw is provided in the proper location. DO NOT RELOCATE.
- Minimum 90° supply conductors.
- Suitable for Wet locations.

GENERAL WIRING DIAGRAM







- Use Dim+, Dim- (DC 10V) marked leads to connect external dimmer circuit. If not connecting to an external 0-10V dimmer circuit, make sure fixture's
 0-10V pink and purple leads are capped off separately. Failure to so do may cause fixture to perform incorrectly, and void warranty.
- The Power Wires and Dimming Wires with shrinkable tubing should not be damaged. (Damage my result in faulty connection).
- Class 1 Wiring Only.

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







HOOK/CHAIN MOUNT

- Install eye-bolt into the fixture and tighten it. (Fig. 1)
- Hang the fixture from the ceiling hook (Fig. 2) or chain (Fig. 3), provided by installer.
- Connect the electrical cables (see general wiring diagram), according to the local wiring rules.









PENDANT MOUNT (Adapter, sold separately)

- Remove the eye-bolt from the driver. (Fig. 4)
- Install the adapter (sold separately) and secure it to the driver using a screw (included with the adapter). (Fig. 5)
- Screw the adapter with the fixture onto a pole and secure it with a screw (included with the adapter). (Fig. 6)
- · Connect the electrical cables (see general wiring diagram), according to the local wiring rules.











CEILING/WALL MOUNT (Bracket, sold separately)


- Using the U-bracket as a template, mark and drill holes in the ceiling (Fig. 7).
- Install the anchors into the drilled holes. (Fig. 8)
- Attach the U-bracket to mounting surface utilizing appropriate hardware based upon the material of the ceiling. (Fig. 9)









CEILING/WALL MOUNT (Bracket, sold separately)


- · Attach mounting feet to the fixture. (Fig. 10)
- Secure the fixture to the ceiling by connecting the U-Bracket to the mounting feet. (Fig. 11)
- Connect the electrical cables (see general wiring diagram), according to the local wiring rules.











ISO - INTEGRATED SENSOR OPTION

Install sensor until firmly seated.

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




EMERGENCY BATTERY
